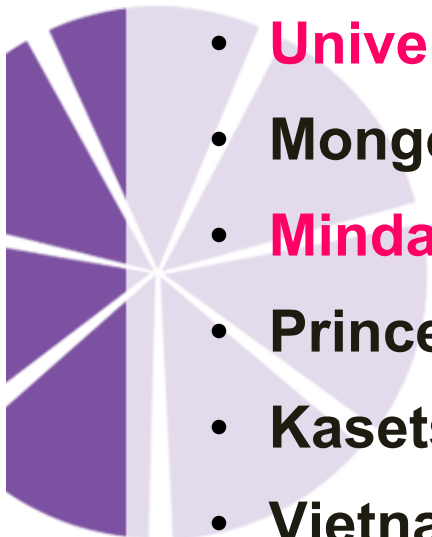
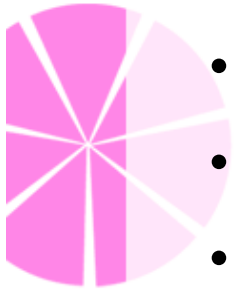

Specific objectives

Elaborate 5-years **Human Resources (HR)** development plans within the partner Universities to identify the needs to upgrade the local teaching and administrative capacities in Asia

Promote cooperation between sending and hosting institutions

To create **innovative opportunities for doctoral qualification** in the mentioned fields, **Enhance the skills and qualifications** of higher education staff

To improve the accessibility of HE for multipliers of knowledge especially those **from the most vulnerable groups**

To further **integrate partners and associates** in international academic networks, both within Asia and the EU

To promote the **creation of joint degrees** (double/multiple degrees)


To **develop complementary cooperation in research**

Improve the **transparency and recognition of studies and qualifications**

Eligible criteria



Must be a national of one of the third countries covered by the relevant lot



Must have not resided nor have carried out their main activity (studies, work, etc.) for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years in one of the European countries



Target groups 1,2 and 3

Target Group 1: **Target group 1**

Students and academic staff registered in one of the partner universities of the consortium at the moment of application. Undergraduate students must have successfully completed at least one year of studies in their home institution.

→ **Undergraduate, Master, PhD, Post-doctoral, Staff**

- **16 Bc for 5 or 10 months**
- **19+8 Msc. for 10 or 24 months**
- **16+8 Phd for 10 or 36 months**
- **5 Post Doc for 6 months**
- **27 Staff for 1 month**

→ **72 from Asia, 38 from EU = 110 mobilities**

Target group 2

Target Group 2:

Nationals of the third-countries concerned by the geographical lot, who:

are registered/work in a higher education institution of these countries that is not included in the

have obtained a university degree or equivalent by an institution of these countries (students only).

This includes the possibility of providing mobility opportunities to third-country nationals working in public administration, public and private enterprises and non-profit organisations

→ **5+2 Masters for 10 or 25 months, 4+1 PhD for 10 or 36 months, 5 Post-doctoral for 6 months, 4 Staff for 1 month**

→ **21 from Asia**

Target Group 3: **Target group 3**

Nationals of the third countries concerned by the geographical lot who are in particularly vulnerable situations, for social and political reasons. For example:

Having a **refugee status or asylum beneficiaries** (international or according to the national legislation of one of the European recipient countries) or

It can be proved that they have been the object of unjustified expulsion from university on racial, ethnic, religious, political, gender or sexual inclination or

They belong to an **indigenous population targeted by a specific national policy** or IDPs (Internally Displaced Persons)

→ **4 Undergraduates for 36 months, 8 Masters for 24 months**

→ **12 from Asia**

Mobility support

The scholarships covers:

Actual travel costs (1 round-ticket) 2000 EUR/2500 EUR

Health insurance 75 EUR/month/person

Monthly subsistence

Mobility plans

Percentages EACEA (Planned mobilities):

Bachelor: 20 – 30% (31 mobilities, 22%)

Master: 20 – 30% (42 mobilities, 29%)

PhD: 15 – 25% (29 mobilities, 20%)

Postdoc: 5 – 15% (10 mobilities, 22%)

Staff: 15 – 25% (31 mobilities, 22%)

Totally 143 mobilities

EU → SEA mobility (TG 1 only!!!)

No fixed quota of incoming students per partner

Mobility (except staff) can start in September 2015

All mobility has to finish before closing date (July 2018)

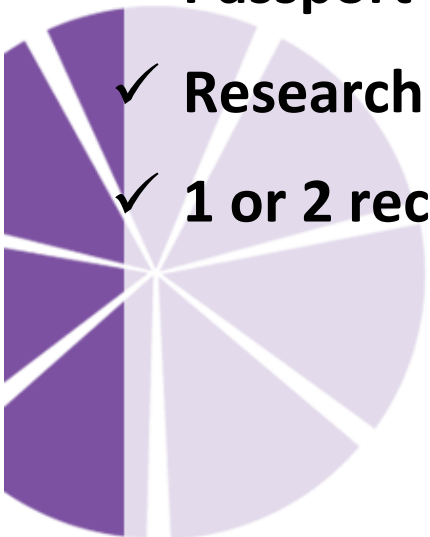


