Applications are open to **postgraduates** who have obtained a master degree (including master thesis) or a doctoral degree (or equivalent degree) in various fields (including e.g. Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Human Medicine, Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities and Arts) as well as to **graduates** in the field of music (only).

→ **Post-doc Grants** (research grants)

Duration: max. 9 months

Grant benefit: 1,040 euros

→ **PhD-Grants**

Grant for a complete PhD programme in Austria

Duration: 36 months

Grant benefit: 940 euros

→ **Sandwich-Grants**

Grant for a partial study period during a PhD programme in Austria

Duration: 12 months

Grant benefit: 940 euros

→ **Music-Grants**

Duration: max. 9 months

Grant benefit: 940 euros

Additionally, scholarship holders receive a travel cost subsidy of max. 730 euros.
